STATEMENT OF THE ACCUSED.

KIYOKATA KUSAKA stands charged before the undersigned H. C. Shaw, Esq., Police Magistrate and one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace in and for the County aforesaid, this 4th day May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, for that the said Kiyokata Kusaka on the 12th day of April 4.D. 1931, at the City of Vencouver did unlawfully have in his possession drugs, to wit: Cocaine and Morphine. Contrary to the Opium and Narcotic Drug Act 1929.

And the said charge being read to the said Kiyokata Kusaka and the witnesses for the prosecution being severally examined in his presence, the said Kiyoka Kusaka is now addressed by me as follows:

Whereupon the said Kiyokata Kusaka says as follows: (through Interpreter)

I reserve defence.

REX VS. KIYOKATA KUSAKA

KIYOKATA KUSAKA charged on the information of Detective H. H. Duggan, of the City of Vancouver on the 13th day of April A.D. 1931, for that at the said city of Vancouver on the 12th day of April A.D. 1931, did unlawfully have in his possession, drugs, to wit: Cocaine and Morphine, contrary to the Opium and Narcotic Drug Act 1929. Contrary to the form of the Statute in such case made and provided. . M. McKey, sq., Counsel for Prosecution.

- J. A. SUTHERLAND, Esq., Counsel for Defence.
- L. H. Heaney sworn stenographer.
- T. Ide sworn Japanese Interpreter.

MR GUTHERLAND: I am appearing for Eusaka.

(Charge read through Interpreter).

COUT: Now tell him Mr. Ide that he has the option to be tried forthwith before me without the intervention of a jury or to remain in custody or under bail as the court decides to be tried in the ordinary way by the court having competent criminal jurisdiction. And ask him how he will be tried?

INTERPRETER: Preliminary hearing Your Worship.

DETECTIVE H. H. DUCGAN, called as a witness, being first sworn, testified as follows:

QUESTIONS BY MR MCKAY:

- 1 4 You are an acting Detective on the Vencouver police force? A. I am.
- This man is charged with having drugs in possession? A: Yes sir.
- To wit cocaine and morphine? A: Yes.

- 4 Q What day did this happen? A: That was on the Sunday, the 12th of April.
- 5 Q Of this month? A: Yes sir.
- 6 Q And where was it ? A: 368 Cordova Street East.
- 7 Q In the City of Vancouver here? A: Yes sir.
- 8 Q What does this man do? A: Apparently he is operating these premises as a hospital for outdoor patients.
- 9 Q Not a qualified physician? A: No sir.
- 10 Q What did you find? A: I found, in regard to drugs, do you mean?
- 11 Q Yes. A: Two boxes containing morphine tablets and one containing cocaine.
- 12 Q These were found in this hospital that he is operating?
- A: Yes sir.
- 13 Q Have you got the certificate there?

 A: Yes sir.

 MR MCKAY: I will put all these drugs in as one Exhibit.

MR MCKAY: Exhibit "A".

COURT: All right.

DRUGS PRODUCED AS EXHIBIT "A".

- 14 Q This is the certificate of John F. C. B. Vance, City and Provincial Analyst?

 A: Yes sir.
- MR MCKAY: To Detective Duggan. Received on the 13th of April certain drugs. Number 2032 contains cocaine, 2033 contains morphine, 2034 contains morphone. All of the above meet the requirements of the Opium and Narcotic Drug Act; and then the different articles are number from 2035 to 2040, that is the containers; John F. C. N. Vance, City and Provincial Analyst. I will put this in as Exhibit "B".

CERPIFICATE PRODUCED AS EXHIBIT "B".

- 15 & Those drugs were taken to the analyst by you? A: Yes sir.
- 16 Q In the same condition as you received them? A: Yes sir.

 MR SUTHERLAND: No questions.

DEFECTIVENC. W. SPENCE, called as a witness, being first sworn, testified as follows:

QUESTIONS BY MR MCKAY:

17 Q You are an acting detective on the Vancouver police force?

A: I am.

18 Q You were in company with Detective Duggan?

A: I was.

19 You have heard his evidence? A: I have

20 Q Is what he says true? A: It is.

21 . Have you got anything to add to that? A: Nothing.

MR SUPHERLAND: No questions.

MR MCKAY: That is the case.

COURT: Well it is a case for committal, Mr. Sutherland.

MR SUTHERLAND: I was going to ask Your Worship if you would postpone the committal until next week so that I can get my bonds ready for the higher court.

MR MCKAY: That is all right.

COURT: No objection Mr McKay?

MR MCKAY: No objection at all.

COURT: Will Monday be all right?

MR SUTHERLAND: Yes Your Worship.

COURT: Remanded to the 4th of May for committal.

Adjourned to May 4th.

MR MCKAY: Kusaka for committal.

court: Just read those two paragraphs Mr Ide. (Interpreter reads warning to the accused).

INTERPRETER: He reserves defence, Your Worship.

COURT: Then I commit him for trial at the first court of competent criminal jurisdiction.
