

Admitted to Hospital - September 10, 1942. Diagnosis - Broncho-pneumonia Physical Examination -Peripheral vessels thickened. Heart enlarged to right. Rales and rhonchi throughout both bungs. Temperature - 103. Laboured respirations, cough, and difficulty in expectorating, even with aid of stimulating expectorants (Ammonium carbonate and Squills) September 11 - Eyelids swollen and red (Acute conjunctivitis) Treatment irrigations and argyrol 10%.
