# Report of INQUIRY as to Cause of Death of

Remarks The deceased was assisting in loading a truck with cord wood at about 10 am Oct. 3/45. After the load was finished he sat down and his fellow workmen noticed that he was sick. He was unable to speak and was carried to a nearby shack. Among the workmen there was a qualified first-aid man who rendered reasonable first aid and accompanied the deceased to the hospital in an ambulance which was immediately summoned. En route to the hospital the man died.
