CERTIFICATE OF NATURALIZATION.

(Rev. Stats. Can., 1906, c. 77, s. 22.)

DOMINION OF CANADA: }
PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA. }

Whereas Gorogi Oikawa..... formerly
of JAPAN..... and now of GOLDEN....., in
(Name of Country.)
the Province of British Columbia, Labourer.
(Occupation.)
has complied with
the requirements of the "Naturalization Act," and has duly resided in Canada for the period
of three years..... And whereas the particulars of the Certificate
granted to the said Gorogi Oikawa..... under the fifteenth
section of the said Act have been duly announced in Court, and thereupon by order of the
said Court the said Certificate has been filed of record in the same pursuant to the said Act.
This is, therefore, to certify to all whom it may concern, that under and by virtue of the said
Act Gorogi Oikawa..... has become
naturalized as a British subject, and is, within Canada, entitled to all political and other rights,
powers and privileges, and is subject to all obligations to which a natural-born British subject
is entitled or subject within Canada, with this qualification that he shall not, when within the
limits of the foreign State of which he was a* subject..... previous to the date
hereof, be deemed to be a British subject unless he has ceased to be a* subject.... of
that State, in pursuance of the laws thereof, or in pursuance of a treaty or convention to that
effect.

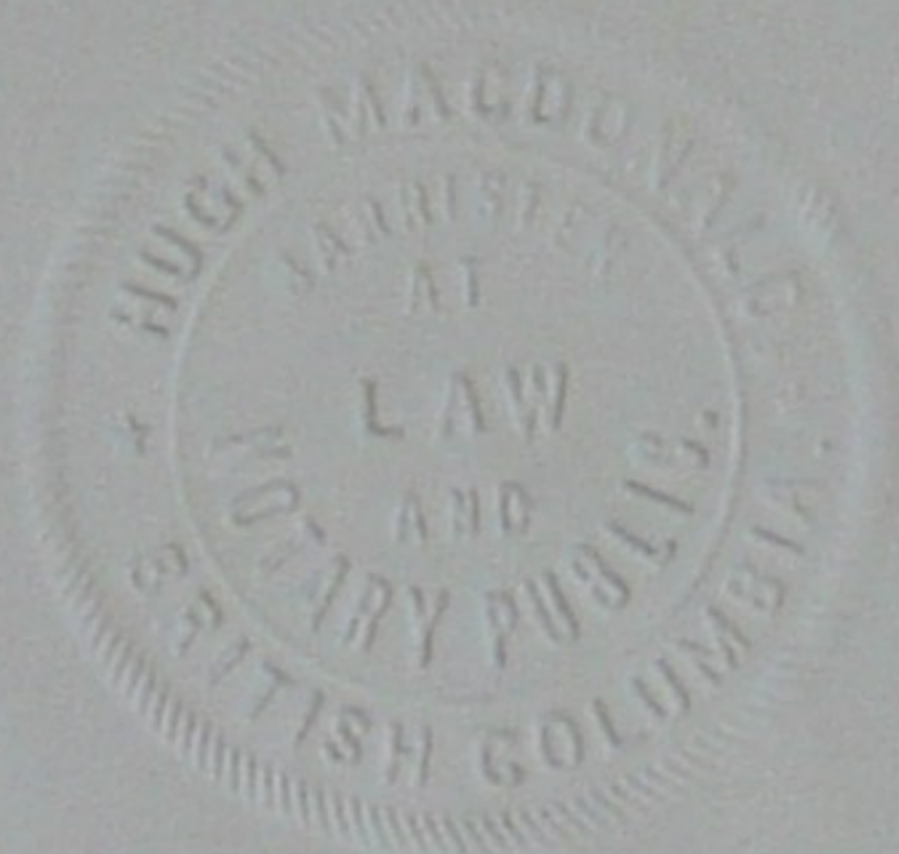

CERTIFICATE UNDER SECTION 10.

I, *Hugh Macdonald*
of *Golden, B.C. Notary Public*, do certify that
that *Goroji Oikawa*, formerly of *Miyagi Ken, Japan*,
but now residing at *Golden B.C.*, an alien, on
the *20th* day of *August*, 191*2*, subscribed and took before me the
Oaths of Residence and Allegiance authorized by the thirteenth section of *The Naturalization Act, Canada*
and therein swore to a residence in Canada of *three* years; that I have reason to
believe, and do believe, that the said *Goroji Oikawa*
within the period of *three* years preceding the said day, has been a resident within Canada
for *three* years; that the said *Goroji Oikawa*
is a person of good character, and that there exists, to my knowledge, no reason why the said
Goroji Oikawa should not be granted all the rights and
capacities of a natural-born British subject.

OATH OF ALLEGIANCE.

I, Goroji Oikawa of Golden B.C. Laborer,, formerly
of Miyagi Ken, in Japan, and known
there by the name of Goroji Oikawa, and now
residing at Golden B.C., do sincerely

promise and swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to His Majesty King George V., as
lawful Sovereign of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and of the Dominion of Canada,
dependent on and belonging to the said Kingdom, and that I will defend Him to the utmost of my power
against all traitorous conspiracies or attempts whatsoever which shall be made against His Person, Crown,
and Dignity, and that I will do my utmost endeavour to disclose and make known to His Majesty, His
Heirs or Successors, all treasons or traitorous conspiracies, and attempts, which I shall know to be against
Him or them; and all this I do swear without any equivocation, mental evasion, or secret reservation. So
help me God.
