Your Worship and Gentlemen:

Re Trades Licenses Issued

Your Special Committee, which was constituted on January 15th, 1940, by Council for the purpose of recommending means whereby the City may have further power to regulate and control the issuance of trades licenses, has held two meetings.

Certain provisions were contained in the Trades License Board Act (now repealed) which made for a better control over the issuance of trade licenses. This Act, also provided for the setting up of an outside Board to give effect to the powers contained therein. Your Committee feels that similar powers, if possessed by the Council itself, and exercised through a Special Committee which would report to Council its recommendations, would be effective and beneficial in giving the City a greater degree of control over trades licenses.

RECOMMENDED that an amendment to Section 163 of the Charter be sought to give effect to the foregoing, which, it is suggested, might be as follows:

"(148a) Without restricting the generality of the foregoing, for refusing or revoking a license to any person if in the opinion of the Council it be advisable in the public interests of the City to do so, having in view

- (1) The better regulation, distribution or zoning in the City of the class of business concerned and the area or street upon which such business is intended to be done or is being done.
- (2) The condition and keeping of the premises in or upon which such business is to be done or is being done;
- (3) The nature of the merchandise or food products or produce kept or to be kept, handled, or offered for sale in such premises;
- (4) The source of supply, or the manner of production or preparation or handling of such merchandise or food products or produce from a health or sanitary standpoint;
- (5) The character or physical condition of the applicant for or holder of the license in question as regards fitness for the nature of the business involved from a health or sanitary standpoint;
- (6) Inability to keep, or persistent failure to keep, proper books in the English language accounting for sales made or to be made in connection with such business."
