Re: Lux Cleaning, Dyeing & Repairing Shop. 3185 Oak Street.

I have been requested to report on conditions existing at the above premises.

The office and repair room in the front of the building consists of one room 14' x 18' with a partition 8' in height between this and the remainder of the building.

The center portion of the building consists of a room, 280 sq. feet, in which are three double beds providing sleeping accommodation, according to the information available, for one man, wife and four children. According to the accepted standards, the floor area which would be necessary to accommodate these would be a minimum of 216 square feet, so that there is ample room for their requirements. We are advised that two other children of this family are living elsewhere with a relative.

There is a 4' passageway leading down the building to the kitchen, which is separated from the sleeping apartment by a 6' partition. The kitchen, which is at the rear and amply lighted with large windows, is 18' x 14' and contains a toilet room 5' x 6' and is provided with a sink. The ceiling is 12' 8" throughout, affording ample light and ventilation above the partitions.

This building was first seen by our District Inspector on July 29th, when it was found that a mezzanine floor had been built for sleeping accommodation and partitions raised beyond the legal limit. The owner and tenants were notified that this was not satisfactory and the attention of the Building Department drawn to the same. On August 5th, further inspection revealed that the orders issued by the Building Department had been complied with.
