

We understand that the boat "Izumi VIII" has been delivered, and that, effective August 4th, she ceased to be at risk with you. Accordingly, we enclose herewith endorsement to policy IMSP 668842 setting forth:-

1. Izumi VIII off risk
2. Item 68 was actually "Izumi VIII"
3. No boats remain at risk under policy.
4. Premiums totalling \$633 charged against individual boats, as per various endorsements to policy, making necessary the crediting back of the \$1800.00 premium originally debited, which was superceded by the simpler method of charging earned premiums against individual boats as they were delivered out of your custody.







The within policy is amended to read and cover as follows and ceases to cover as heretofore:

### ENDORSEMENT

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED that the boats listed under Schedule "A", attached hereto, all of which were received by the Assured on March 25th, 1942, remain on hand with the Assured as of the date of this endorsement, and remain covered in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this policy.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED that the boats listed under Schedule "B", attached hereto, are similarly covered under the terms and conditions of this policy, but effective only beginning at noon P.S.T. on the dates set opposite each boat concerned.

ALSO UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED that the boats listed under Schedule "C", attached hereto, all of which were described in this policy, ceased to be at risk as of the dates of disposal set opposite each boat concerned, and that the earned premium shown opposite each boat is in accordance with the records of the Assured.






