Win Awmack talking to Ruth Chambers on February 21,1985, about the final months at Tashme thecamp always called a relocation camp though it was really an internment camp at Trite's Ranch which was just east of where, later, the Hope Slide occurred. This tape is a continuation of 4 Tashme tapes done in
