Statement made by J. A. Grant
Prairie Markets Commissioner

Before the British Columbia Fruit Growers' Convention
in January, 1927.

A system to control perishable produce in a manner that would stabilize the supply required to feed the market would result in a greatly increased distribution. Unless control is secured by penalty against offenders it will not be effective. The two great factors that lessen distribution are too high, and unprofitably low prices. The first retards buying a commodity as the price forces it into the luxury class, causing the consuming public to seek a cheaper substitute, and the second case encourages purchasers to hold off buying as on a falling market, and daily reductions in prices are waited for. The perishable produce not consumed in its day is lost to consumption.

The smallest consumption of apples on the prairies occurred in 1922 when prices were at their lowest.
