Re Grants in Aid of Salaries for Japanese
and Chinese Nurses

I beg to notify you of the following recommendation which was made by the Social Service Commission on the 15th instant, not yet adopted by Council:

"On May 15th, 1940, the Metropolitan Health Committee received a report from the Senior Medical Health Officer re request for a grant in aid of salaries for Japanese and Chinese nurses, pointing out that the Metropolitan Health Committee budget has no available funds from which the necessary sum of \$600.00 could be obtained, and suggesting that the matter be referred to the Social Service Commission.

The Commission, having considered this matter, begs to recommend that the question be referred to the Social Services Committee with the suggestion that a Special Committee be appointed to consider and report upon the matter, and that such Committee should include a representative of the Vancouver Welfare Federation."

Sewer Connection: 3275 W. 30th Ave. (Cont'd)

It is therefore recommended as follows:

"The owner of Lot 24, Block 65, District Lot 2027, in the City of Vancouver, being within 150 feet of a public sewer, and having been given 14 days' notice as prescribed under the provisions of Section 51 of By-law No. 2008, and such owner having defaulted in making such connection aforesaid, it is hereby ordered that such property be connected up with such public sewer, as recommended by the Medical Health Officer in that behalf. The actual cost of such connecting up as shall be certified by the Building Inspector shall be added to the taxes of such lot or parcel of land on the Collector's roll and shall be treated in all respects as ordinary taxes due upon the said land as in said By-law made and provided."

4. Re Burnaby Cemetery Site: Application to Cut Alder.

The Medical Health Officer submitted an application from Cecil Hart, 5190 Union Street, requesting permission to cut Alder on the Burnaby Cemetery site.

Recommended that this correspondence be laid on the table for further investigation.

5. Re Routine Report of the Medical Health Officer

Recommended that the report submitted by the Medical Health Officer with regard to cases of communicable diseases reported from May 5th to May 18th, 1940, be received and filed.

6. Re Exclusive Ambulance Service: Revision of Contract.

A communication was submitted from Exclusive Ambulance Service requesting that a Committee be appointed to revise the existing contract.

Recommended that a Special Committee be appointed in this matter, consisting of Aldermen Miller and Corey, the City Comptroller, the Medical Health Officer and the Social Service Administrator; for report.
