Understanding that the Dept of Labour has issued notice to all Japanese dependants in Kado that they are to be transferred to New Denver before March 31st and ^{understandings} that these people are awaiting placement in Eastern Canada, which will ^{take place} within a few weeks we would suggest and do recommend that these people be left in their present locations until that time, thus saving ^{the} considerable expense of moving them to New Denver, also saving ~~great~~ unnecessary distress to these people and disruption of the children's schooling this late in the school term. These families could be supervised from New Denver office as is Rosebery and other points, if the Mounted Police officer was retained here for that time.
