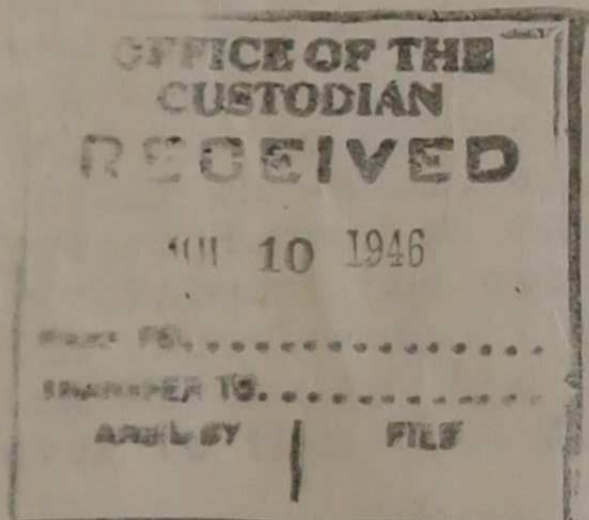

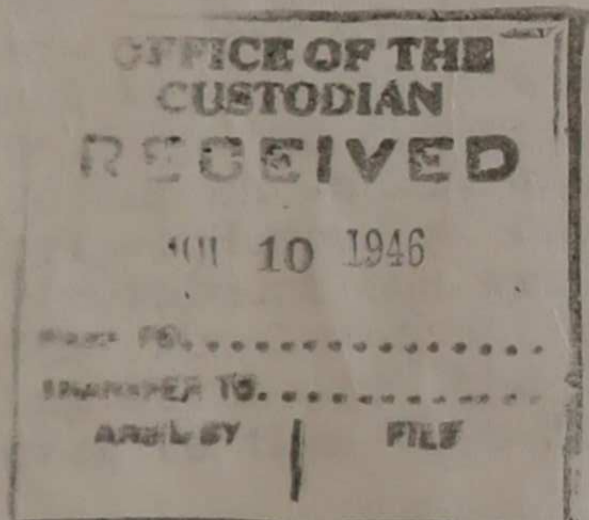

We, Japanese Repatriates of Slocan District, sincerely believe that as a result of coercive evacuation from the Pacific Coast, thereby resulting in considerable financial loss to the affected people, a great deal of consideration should be forthcoming from the government of the Dominion of Canada.

Ever since the outbreak of the Pacific war, we have been treated unfairly and undemocratically, the Germans and the Italians, however, were immune from such treatment. Even the Canadian-Born and the Naturalized Canadians were removed from defence area. The direct consequence of this government policy was quite obvious. The family life was temporarily disrupted, we were forced to live for months in an unsanitary and crowded Manning Pool at Hastings Park in Vancouver. It is quite clear to what extent these people received the blow psychologically. Apart from this, the financial loss sustained by each family was considerable, but to ascertain to what extent is quite impossible. Before leaving the coast, a great portion of household effects and personal belongings were either unwillingly relinquished or reluctantly sold at a loss, but, for those who are old or who are approaching old age, this action, though unfortunately unavoidable, has resulted in a financial uneasiness to such an extent that the possibility of the re-establishment of their former financial status seems quite dim.

On the solemn promise that the property handed over to the Custodian would be safeguarded in the interest of the owner, we had complete faith, but unfortunately, this pledge was not kept. Both the moveable and the immoveable properties were sold by the Custodian without the consent of the owner, at either one-half, one-third or one-fourth of their current price. Hence, no one can doubt in the least the profound disappointment and grief arising from such injustice. Furthermore the unemployed and those unable to work in the Interior Housing Settlement had to live on what money the Custodian handed over to them from the forced sale of their property.

It is now quite evident that a great majority of the evacuees' were stripped of all financial assets.

In the name of those who are going to Japan voluntarily or involuntarily in the very near future to re-establish themselves there, we, Japanese Repatriates of Slocan District, do hereby humbly petition that the enormous financial loss sustained by the Japanese people as a result of this forced evacuation from the coast be indemnified by the government of the Dominion of Canada.

We trust this entreaty on the good faith of His Majesty's Government and on the benevolence of the Canadian people.

MEMORANDUM

FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE :

I am attaching documents, forwarded here by the Department of Labour, which purport to be claims by persons of the Japanese race, presumably evacuated from the defence area, in relation to their properties.

Since the communications are all prepared on typewritten forms identical in phraseology, it is apparent that this is part of an organized movement among persons of the Japanese race evacuated from the defence area. You will observe, for instance, that in the claim of Yonezo Nishi - the top one on the file - there is an item in respect to the alleged value of a fishing boat sold by the Fishing Boat Commission set up by the Government in 1942, and then there is a claim for an estimated lack of income by reason of the evacuation.

I may remind you that most of the fishing vessels were sold, in the summer of 1942, by the Fishing Vessel Commission set up by the Government under the Department of Fisheries. The records of the dealings of this Commission and the proceeds of the sales were turned over to the Custodian in 1943, the net proceeds in each case being held to the credit of the former Japanese owner.

In February 1943 the Custodian was directed to dispose of the properties in the defence area of persons of the Japanese race who had been evacuated from the defence area and this has been carried out under the supervision of two advisory committees, one headed by Mr. Justice Smith of the Appeal Court of British Columbia, dealing with properties in Greater Vancouver, and the other by Judge Whiteside, dealing with properties in the rural area. Great care appears to have been exercised in the sales and, with all respect to the persons now submitting claims, a cursory examination of them would indicate that most of them are quite fantastic.


I do not wish, however, to take any action, even to the extent of an acknowledgment, without your direction.

We recognized, from the outset, that there was a strong possibility that claims of this nature would be submitted at a later date and therefore every precaution was taken to see that the prices obtained for the properties were fair and reasonable. It may develop, if this campaign proceeds, that it may be desirable for the Government to appoint an independent Commissioner to go over the records of the sales but I question whether at this stage such expense would be justified. I could, of course, if you desire it, have an examination made of the records in Vancouver relating to each of the claims submitted but this would

throw ---

throw on our small staff in Vancouver a great deal of work with probably no practical result.

As I have said, in view of the fact that the forms are identical, it seems quite clear that some group or organization among the evacuated Japanese is endeavouring to build up claims against the Government.

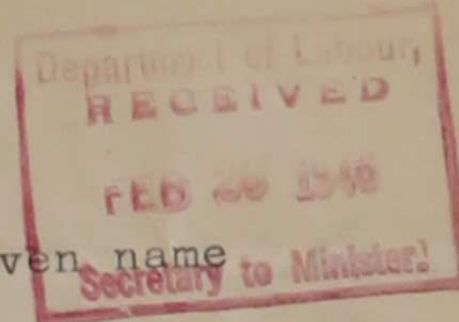

Dear Sir:

Now we have the honour of submitting this document to your excellency, the Minister of Justice.

Well it is very irrational that the government dispersal policy for the Japanese and plainly speaking from what as our believing are, it might originate in racial prejudice. We, herewith, are very regrettable because the policy enforced by the Canadian Government professed consistently democracy.

Though we were obliged to signed the application for repatriation under the policy, our attitudes for many years were consistently obedient, law-abiding, and had endured from much persecutions which were given toward Japanese. We have, as they all know, engaged diligently into many industries and our contributions were great.

The outbreak of this war was our greatest regrettable thing, but, as it has not come from our responsibilities at all, in spite of harsh treatment as enemies aliens, we never caused any obstacles for carrying the victorious war out for Canada. Rather, we exerted ourselves to increase Canadian fighting power during the war, while our economic and spiritual blows were deep.

At present, we are leaving forever from Canada, to the effect that in co-operation with the government policy. In regard to our forthcoming re-settlement, we expect the government natural consideration at a point of view of justice and humanity.
