Dear l.r. Henry:

With reference to my letter of Jeptember 7th, I have now to inform you that so far as I am aware there is no Dominion legislation on the subject of racial discrimination.

As intimated in my letter of September 7th, I wrote to the Attorneys-Seneral of all the provinces and have now received replies from every province except Frince Edward Island.

The only Provincial legislation on the subject of which I am aware is contained in the libel Act of Manitoba, being chapter 119, R.S.M. 1940. Section 14 thereof reads as follows:

"14. (1) The publication of a libel against a race or creed likely to expose persons belonging to the race or professing the creed to hatred, contempt or ridicule, and tending to raise unrest or disorder among the people, shall entitle a person belonging to the race or professing the creed to sue for an injunction to prevent the continuation and circulation of the libel; and the Court of King's Bench is empowered to entertain the action.

(2) The action may be taken against the person responsible for the authorship, publication, or circulation of the libel.
