### Re: Japanese External Assets.

In co-operation with Mr. Frederick Field we have prepared Statements of enemy interests in companies and of the interest of individual Japanese resident in Japan. These statements are enclosed in duplicate.

The amount of \$255,718.70 is arrived at apart from the figures which are typed in red. The red figures merely indicate the liability due to an enemy, but as there are unsufficient funds it will not be possible for these amounts to be paid and for this reason, as mentioned above, they are not included in the total.

The totals referred to above are also dependent upon the final realization of other assets which are listed as \$646,321.07 and an explanation of these other assets is provided in the Memorandum attached to the statement.

We also attach a Memorandum in regard to the assets listed under the names of Cartwright Lumber Company Limited, Deshaw Company Limited and Trans-Pacific Lumber Company Limited.

The total assets held for residents in Japan is \$589,235.58, thereby making a combined total of Company and Individual assets of \$2,201,422.19.

### Re: Japanese External Assets.

In co-operation with Mr. Frederick Field we have prepared Statements of enemy interests in companies and of the interest of individual Japanese resident in Japan. These statements are enclosed in duplicate.

The amount of \$255,718.70 is arrived at apart from the figures which are typed in red. The red figures merely indicate the liability due to an enemy, but as there are unsufficient funds it will not be possible for these amounts to be paid and for this reason, as mentioned above, they are not included in the total.

The totals referred to above are also dependent upon the final realization of other assets which are listed as \$646,321.07 and an explanation of these other assets is provided in the Memorandum attached to the statement.

We also attach a Memorandum in regard to the assets listed under the names of Cartwright Lumber Company Limited, Deshaw Company Limited and Trans-Pacific Lumber Company Limited.

The total assets held for residents in Japan is \$589,235.58, thereby making a combined total of Company and Individual assets of \$2,201,422.19.
