

o ssord Punto P.C. 3812 AT THE GOVERNMENT HOUSE AT OTTAWA THURSDAY, the 23rd day of NOVEMBER, 1939. PRESENT: HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL --WHEREAS the Minister of Justice reports that the procedure relating to appeals by enemy aliens against internment, set out in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of Regulation 26 of the Defence of Canada Regulations, has not resulted in a prompt and just disposition of such appeals; That in the opinion of the Minister a more speedy disposition of such appeals would result by the designation by the Minister of Justice of one or more persons for the hearing of such appeals, who would proceed to the various internment camps and dispose of same; and That the person designated, referred to in the Regulation as a Tribunal, should be empowered to administer oaths and to receive and accept such evidence and information on oath, affidavit or otherwise as in his discretion he may deem fit and proper: THEREFORE His Excellency the Governor General in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister of Justice and under and by virtue of the provisions of the War Measures Act, Chapter 206 of the Revised Statutes of Canada 1927, is pleased to order and doth hereby order and direct that the procedure set out in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of Regulation 26 of the Defence of Canada Regulations (P.C. 2483, 3rd September, 1939) shall apply only to appeals of enemy aliens, notices of which were filed with the Director of Internment Operations before the first day of November, 1939. His Excellency in Council is further pleased, under the above cited authority, to amend the said Defence of Canada Regulations and they are hereby amended by rescinding para-Canada Sazette 2-12-39 P. 1753 graphs (1), (2) and (3) of Regulation 26 and substituting therefor the following paragraphs, which shall apply to appeals of enemy aliens filed with/
