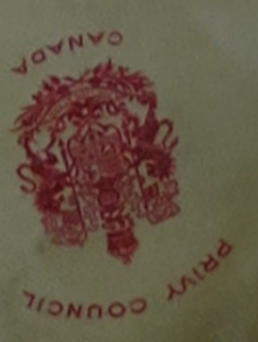

WHEREAS by Order in Council, P.C. 2483,
of the 3rd day of September, 1939, the Defence of
Canada Regulations were made and established;

AND WHEREAS the said Regulations and
amendments thereto were, by Order in Council, P.C. 4750,
of the 12th day of September, 1940, consolidated under
the heading "Defence of Canada Regulations (Consolid-
ation) 1940";

AND WHEREAS the said Regulations have been
further amended from time to time;

AND WHEREAS the Special Committee on the
Defence of Canada Regulations, appointed by resolution
of the House of Commons adopted on the 4th March,
1941, in making its fourth and final report on the
4th day of June, 1941, which was concurred in by the
House of Commons on the 9th day of June, 1941, recom-
mended that the said Regulations, as amended, be
consolidated and reprinted.

THEREFORE, His Excellency the Governor
General in Council, on the recommendation of the
Minister of Justice, and under and by virtue of the
power vested in the Governor in Council by the War
Measures Act, Chapter 206 of the Revised Statutes
of Canada 1927, is pleased to order and doth hereby
order as follows:

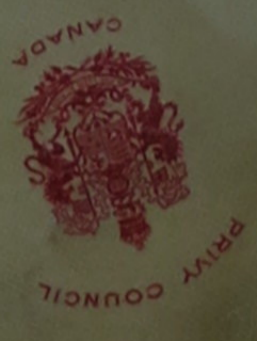
1. The Defence of Canada Regulations (Con-
solidation) 1940, established by Order in Council,
P.C. 4750, of the 12th September, 1940, as amended,
are hereby revoked effective on and from the coming
into force of the Defence of Canada Regulations
(Consolidation) 1941, as provided in paragraph 5 hereof.

2. The attached Defence of Canada Regulations
(Consolidation) 1941, numbered 1 to 65, inclusive,
are hereby made and established in substitution for
the Regulations hereby revoked.

5. The said Defence of Canada Regulations (Consolidation) 1941, shall come into force and have effect on, from and after the 28th day of July, 1941.

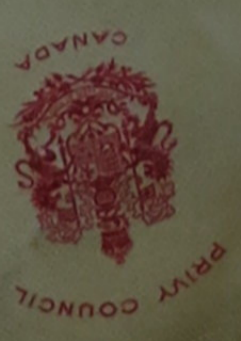
