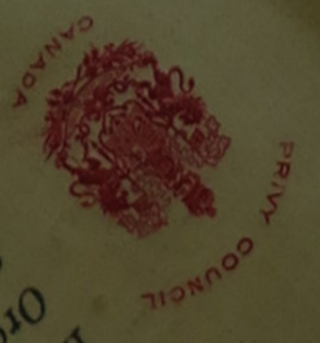

The Committee of the Privy Council have had before them a report, dated 1st June, 1942, from the Minister of Mines and Resources, stating as follows:-

Titles to the lands described in the annexed Schedule "A" stand in the name of the Director of Soldier Settlement. Advances were made on mortgage security under the provisions of the Soldier Settlement Act, but the soldier settlers involved, for various reasons, abandoned their respective farms and each of them executed a Quit Claim Deed in favour of the Director or his predecessors, or title was obtained pursuant to the institution of foreclosure proceedings under the respective mortgages.

The lands described in the Schedule are now available for sale by the Director and they have been posted for sale by public tender and other efforts have been made to effect their resale on the most favourable terms obtainable.

The Director has recommended that sale of the parcels listed in the annexed Schedule "A" be authorized at the respective prices shown therein such prices in his opinion representing the fair present day selling values of the parcels. The Director has further reported that all efforts to sell the lands upon more favourable terms have been unsuccessful.

The Committee, on the recommendation of the Minister of Mines and Resources, advise that sale of the said lands be approved, accordingly.
