

- (1) That it is further agreed that in the event the gardens or forum buildings are released for the use of the Vancouver Exhibition Association, the annual rental would be reduced at the rate of \$10,000 per annum or \$833.33 per month from the date when such buildings were turned over for the use of the Association.
- (2) That the nine-hole golf course bounded by Hastings Park and Windermere Street, exclusive of the club house, may be taken over by the Crown on thirty day's notice at no extra cost provided that such golf course is returned in a condition equal to that when taken over.
- (3) That the grandstand and racetrack may be taken over by the Crown at no extra cost, provided such grandstand and racetrack are returned to the Exhibition Association in sufficient time for race meets to be held and that same shall be returned in a condition satisfactory to hold such race meets.
- (4) That all buildings and premises occupied by the Crown shall be returned in a condition equal to that when taken over.
- (5) That the Vancouver Exhibition Association shall be responsible for damage by fire, tempest, windstorm, acts of God and The King's enemies, and taxes (if any).
- (6) That the Crown shall be responsible for complete maintenance, water, light, and power.
- (7) That the Crown shall have the right to remove all fixtures and equipment installed on the premises by the Crown.

The Committee, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Labour, advise that the terms and conditions outlined above be approved.
