

Honourable Privy Counc to 19b10 oldon 420M odt Major-General the Right The Committee of the Privy Council have had before them a report, dated 8th December, 1942, from the Minister of Labour, representing that National Selective Service Mobilization Regulations, established by Order in Council P.C. 10924, dated the first day of December, 1942, provide that men of any age classes, class or part of any age class, may be designated for purposes of said regulations by proclamation of the Governor in Council, and that it is now expedient that there be issued subject to these regulations a proclamation designating men for the purposes of these regulations who were on the fifteenth day of July, nineteen hundred and forty, married, or widowers with child or children and who were born in any of the years 1923, 1922, 1921, 1920, 1919, 1918, 1917, but providing nevertheless that persons born in the year 1923 are not so designated until they reach the age of nineteen years. GREETING: PROGLAMATION P. P. VARCOE Deputy Minister of Justice, Canada WHEREAS it is provided by the National Resources Mobilization Act, 1940, that the Governor in Council may make from time to time such orders and regulations requiring persons to place themselves, their services and their property at the disposal of his Majesty in the right of Canada, as may be deemed necessary or expedient for securing the public safety, the defence of Canada, the maintenance of public order, or the efficient prosecution of the war, or for maintaining supplies or services essential to the life of the community; AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers therein contained, and provisions of The War Measures Act, our Governor in Council did on the first day of December, nineten hundred and forty-two, make regulations to provide a system for ordering out men for military training, service or duty within Canada and the territorial waters thereof, such regulations being now known as National Selective Service Mobilization Regulations; AND WHEREAS, all such persons ordered out pursuant to the said National Selective Service Mobilization Regulations are liable to perform military training, service or duty pursuant to the Reserve Army (Special) Regulations, 1941, within Canada and the territorial waters thereof, as the Minister of National Defence (Army) may from time to time require: AND WHEREAS, pursuant to and in accordance with the said National Selective Service Mobilization Regulations there have been designated by proclemation within the meaning of section three thereof, every male British subject who is or who has been at any time subsequent to the first day of September, 1939, ordinarily resident in Canada, and every male person in Canada, other than a non-declarant enemy alien within the meaning of the said Regulations, who has been in Canada throughout the year immediately prior to his being ordered to report under the said Regulations for medical examination, whether or not he has been temporarily absent from Canada during such year, and who was on the 15th day of July, 1940, unmarried or a widower without child or children, or has since the said date been divorced or judicially separated, or 100 become a widower without child or children, and who was born in any of the years, 1923, 1922, 1921, 1920, 1919, 1918, 1917, 1916, 1915, 1914, 1913, 1912, 1911, 1910, 1909, 1908, 1907, 1906, 1905, 1904, 1903, 1902, except nevertheless, that persons 1906, 1905, 1904, 1903, 1902, except nevertheless, that persons born in the year 1923 are not so designated until they reach the age of 19 years;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to and in accordance with National Selective Service Mobilization Regulations it has been decided to designate by proclamation within the meaning of Section three thereof every male British subject who is or who has been at any time subsequent to the first day of September, 1939, ordinarily resident in Canada, and every male person in Canada, other than a non-declarant enemy alien within the meaning of the said Regulations, who has been in Canada throughout the year immediately prior to his being ordered to report under the said Regulations for medical examination, whether or not he has been temporarily absent from Canada during such year, and who was on the 15th day of July, 1940, married or a widower with child or children, and who was born in any of the years, 1923, 1922, 1921, 1920, 1919, 1918, 1917, but that persons born in the year 1928 shall not be so designated until they reach the age of 19 years;

NOW THEREFORE KNOW YE, that, pursuant to the Mational Resources Mobilization Act, 1940, and the War Measures Act, and pursuant to and in accordance with the Mational Selective Service Mobilization Regulations, we do hereby designate the aforesaid classes of men to submit themselves for medical examination and to undergo and perform military training, service or duty within Canada, or the territorial waters thereof, during the sate of war now existing, as the Minister of Mational Defence may from time to time require, pursuant to the Reserve Army (Special) Regulations, 1941, or such other Regulations as may be applicable, and to report at such places and times and in such manner and to such authorities or persons as may be ordered or notified to them by a Divisional Registrar of an Administrative Division appointed by the Governor in Council pursuant to the said National Selective Service Mobilization Regulations.
