#### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it seems to us fitting that a day should be set apart by the people of Canada as a day of Prayer and of Solemn Thanksgiving to Almighty God

for the Victory granted to the cause of freedom against Japanese aggression and for the termination of active hostilities in the great War in which Canada and other of the United Nations have been engaged.


NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada, have thought fit to appoint 19th day of August, 1945, to be observed Sunday, the throughout Canada as a day of Prayer and Solemn Thanksgiving to Almighty God for the termination of active hostilities in the war against Japan;

AND FURTHER that the said day be observed throughout Canada as a day of Remembrance of the heroism of the men and women of Canada and of the other United Nations who have given their lives in the war, and of those who have suffered wounds or have endured captivity in enemy hands, and of the courage and fortitude with which so many of our citizens have borne heavy burdens of bereavement and anxiety;

AND FURTHER that the said day be observed as a day of Rededication under Almighty God in the effort for the restoration, on a firm and enduring basis of justice and right, of peace and accord among the nations of the world.

AND WE DO INVITE by this Our Proclamation all Our Loving Subjects throughout Canada to set apart the said day for this purpose.

OF ALL WHICH Our Loving Subjects and all others whom these Presents may concern, are hereby required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.
