

P.C. 5793 AT THE GOVERNMENT HOUSE AT OTTAWA TUESDAY, the 18th day of DECEMBER, 1945. PRESENT: HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL: WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by reason of the war for the peace, order and welfare of Canada to amend, as hereinafter provided, the regulations established by Order in Council P.C. 946 of February 5, 1943, providing for the placement, control and maintenance of persons of the Japanese race in Canada; NOW, THEREFORE, His Excellency the Governor General in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister of Labour, and under the authority of the War Measures Act, is pleased to amend the said regulations and they are hereby further amended by deleting the words "from residing in any place in Canada" in paragraph (viii) of subsection one of section three thereof and substituting therefor the words "from residing in any place or area in Canada".
