THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL:

WHEREAS by Order in Council P.C. 7355 of December 15, 1945, provision is made to permit persons proceeding to Japan under an order for deportation issued under the said Order in Council or who, having made a request for repatriation, are proceeding to Japan without the issue of an order for deportation, to purchase suitable foreign exchange to the extent of any money in the possession or standing to the credit of such person in Canada or advanced to him by the Minister under the provisions of section seven of the said Order in Council and to take such foreign exchange out of Canada with him;

AND WHEREAS following discussions with the United States Treasury authorities, it is proposed that the procedure hereinafter set out be followed to give effect to the foregoing;

NOW, THEREFORE, His Excellency the Governor General in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister of Labour, is pleased to approve and doth hereby approve the following arrangements for the exchange of monies in the possession of or standing to the credit in Canada of or advanced by the Minister of Labour under section seven of Order in Council P.C. 7355 of December 15, 1945, to, any person for whom an order for deportation is made under the authority of P.C. 7355 aforesaid or who, having made a request for repatriation, is proceeding to Japan without the issue of such authority under arrangements made by the Minister of Labour;

1. Such Canadian funds shall be exchanged on the basis of the present United States military rate of conversion, namely 15 Japanese yen to the United States dollar, for yen receipts issued by the Government of Canada, such receipts to be in form presented by the Comptroller of the Treasury and acceptable to the United States authorities.

2. Funds in United States dollars equivalent to the value of the yen receipts issued at the aforesaid rate of conversion will be placed to the credit of the United States authorities in a special account established for that purpose.

3. By arrangements with the United States Treasury authorities and through them with the Supreme Commander for the Allied Forces in Japan, the yen receipts so issued may be cashed in Japan by the person to whom issued.

4. The Department of Labour and the Comptroller of the Treasury shall make necessary arrangements for the issue of yen receipts as above and shall complete necessary arrangements with the United States Treasury authorities to implement the foregoing.
