May I direct your attention, particularly, to the following paragraphs:

- Par. 5: Employment of Canadian destroyers.
- Par. 8: Transfer of A/S units from the Pacific Coast.
- Par. 16-17: Report of C.G.S.
- Par. 25: Employment of Japanese in British Columbia.
- Par. 29: Proposed U.S. military hospital at Edmonton.
(I shall see that you have the report of the J.D.C.P.P.)
- Par. 33: Alaska highway; postwar military use, etc.
(I shall arrange to call a meeting of the Chiefs of Staff and the Canadian Section of the P.J.B.D. for early next week.)
- Par. 35: Provincial highway - Edmonton to Dawson Creek; federal assistance.
- Par. 40: Proposals for conferences with the United Nations.
- Par. 42: Legal position of U.S. forces in Canada.
