22nd February, 1943. URGENT BY HAND F. P. Varcoe Esq., Deputy Minister of Justice Ottawa, Ontario. Dear Mr. Varcoe, I enclose submission to Council(P.C. 1422) recommending suspension and cancellation for the duration of the war of restrictions on the employment of Chinese and Japanese in the B.C. timber industry. At todays meeting Council directed that this recommendation be referred to you for consideration with particular reference to the use of the word "cancellation" in the 7th paragraph and in section 1. It was felt that this word should, unless legally necessary, be eliminated or replaced by another word.
