Sept.19th	<u>Repatriation and re-location of persons of Japanese race</u> - Recommendations special Cabinet committee approved and agreed action be taken accordingly.	LAB.	Telegram has been despatched to Gen. MacArthur through the Can. Embassy at Washington requesting information as to when Japanese can be repatriated and deported from Canada. Until a reply is received it does not appear advisable to hold further meetings of the Cabinet Committee studying this problem. (Rcvd. 27/9/45)

Committee</u> - Agreed reply to premier B.C. re approval appointment of representatives of government and C.N.R. to joint committee B.C.; with reservation no commitment implied on behalf government and joint committee's report be purely fact-finding document.
