Q Even when the boat was sold? A: At the time I sold the boat the person who bought it said he didn't want it and I, therefore, just sold the boat alone, therefore I left it in the cannery house.

Q This was after you made your J.P. form, is that correct? A: Before I made the J.P. form, before I signed the J.P. form.

10 Q Well, did you sell the boat before or after you signed the J.P. form? A: It was after I signed the J.P. form that I sold the boat.

Q That you sold the boat? A: Yes.

Q Why didn't you list the boat equipment in your J.P. form? A: I included them in the other goods that I listed with the Custodian; I didn't itemize them at all.

Q I would like my friend to produce the net statement which he has.

You prepared this net statement, Mr. Motoda?

A Yes.

Q That was done before May 1st, 1943?

A I don't remember when I made it, but I did make the statement.

Q Well, it has the stamp of the Custodian of May 1st, 1943; it must have been made before that date?

A Yes, it must have been made before.

Q Now, you are claiming in your summary of evidence for certain nets. Are these the same nets?




