WHEREAS under or by virtue of Order-in-Council No. P.C. 1665 of 1942 and amendments thereto including P.C. 2483 of 1942 and P.C. 469 of 1943 and of the applicable provisions of the Revised Regulations Respecting Trading With The Enemy (1943) the property of TAKASHI YAMASAKI, HIKOYE YAMASAKI, TAKAAKI YAMASAKI and TOKUICHI YAMASAKI has become vested in and made subject to the control of the Secretary of State of Canada acting in his capacity as Custodian.

AND WHEREAS under or by virtue of the said Orders-in-Council and Regulations a certificate, dated the 22nd day of June, 1942, stating that the interests of the said TAKASHI YAMASAKI, HIKOYE YAMASAKI, TAKAAKI YAMASAKI and TOKUICHI YAMASAKI in Municipality of Maple Ridge Lot Twelve (12) of the West half - (1/2) of Section Twenty (20); Township Twelve (12), Map One Thousand One Hundred and Sixty-One (1161) in the District of New Westminster, are vested in the Custodian, were registered in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, on the 29th day of June, A.D. 1942, under No. 24226.

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State of Canada acting in his capacity as Custodian under or by virtue of the Orders-in-Council aforesaid and the Revised Regulations Respecting Trading With The Enemy (1943) by his duly authorized and lawful Deputy, hereby requests that the title of the said land or interests therein be transferred into the name of "The Secretary of State of Canada acting in his capacity as Custodian under the Revised Regulations Respecting Trading With The Enemy (1943)"
