CLOCKS: Will be advanced 40 minutes at 2.00 a.m.

The Captain and Ship's Company welcome on board those passengers who join us in Yokohama today and sincerely hope you have a comfortable and enjoyable voyage in "Arcadia".

At 5 o'clock this afternoon all newly joined passengers are requested to assemble in the "A" Deck Galleries with their lifebelts for instructions in the procedure to be carried out in the most unlikely event of an emergency. The alarm bells will be given a short ring at this time.

LONG RANGE BINGO:

Fifteen numbers will be published daily, in the "Good Morning Sheet" commencing tomorrow and the first game will be for the TOP line followed by the FULL HOUSE. You cross off the numbers just as if you were playing ordinary Bingo. When you have the TOP line you claim to the Sportsdeck Quartermaster in the Gallery by Noon on the day you complete it, similarly with the FULL HOUSE.

The Winner in each case is that person who completes their "line" or "house" with the number nearest the first published. For example, supposing the numbers were 25, 77, 16, 52, 18, 34, 63, 9, 86, etc. and one person completed a line with the number 63 and another with 77 then the person completing with 77 would be the winner and receive the prize.
