This is further to letters received from the Registrar of Canadian Citizenship of October 5, 1950 and January 25, 1951 concerning the citizenship of Yoshiko Iwasaki now residing in Japan.

In letter of January 25, 1951 I was advised that Miss Iwasaki had no claim to Canadian citizenship. It is still her foremost desire to enter Canada to join her family, and for this reason, I have been asked to write to you to exercise your authority to permit her to enter, or, to have a general revision of the immigration regulations to permit a limited number of immigrants to enter Canada from Japan.
