I am writing on behalf of Hyosaku Iwasaki, 137 Winchester Street, Toronto, who states that his daughter, Yoshiko, in Shizuokaken, Japan, wishes to regain her Canadian citizenship in order to be able to enter Canada for permanent residence.

Yoshiko Iwasaki was born in Shizuoka-ken on January 8, 1925. Her father, Hyosaku Iwasaki, was naturalized on October 11, 1907, at the Vancouver Court House and has continuously retained his citizenship since that time.

Should it be possible for Yoshiko Iwasaki to regain her Canadian citizenship, she would also seek the permission of the Minister to file a declaration of resumption of Canadian citizenship and a declaration of renunciation.
