This is in reply to your letter dated April 26, 1954, concerning the assets for which the Custodian's cheque in the amount of \$28,373.16 Can. was received by Mr. Kasho.

According to the Application for Release of Assets, which I believe Mr. Kasho sent to the Custodian, paragraph 4, as draft by myself, reads as follows:

"That this application is for the release of assets in the amount of twenty-eight thousand, nine hundred fifty-two dollars and twenty cents (\$28,952.20), being the amount reported as held by the Custodian after liquidating my assets which included among other items, three (3) seine boats, namely, Izumi II, Izumi III and Izumi V, and one (1 only) fish packer, namely, Izumi VIII, all located in the Province of British Columbia."
