

The Naturalization Act RSC 1906 ch 77

S. 13 - Provides alien may subject to certain conditions take oath and apply for certificate as a British subject.

Term of not less than 3 yrs.

Oaths of residence & allegiance in Form A & apply for certificate in Form B

S. 14 - The following persons shall be competent to administer such oath, namely

(a) A judge of a court of record in Canada;

(b) A commissioner authorized to administer oaths in any court of record in Canada;

(c) A Commissioner authorized by the g/c to take oaths under this Act;

(d) A justice of the peace;

(e) A notary public;

(f) A stipendiary magistrate, or a police magistrate

S. 15 - The alien shall address, in support of such application, such evidence of his residence or service, and intention to reside or serve, as the person before whom he takes the oath aforesaid requires; and such person, on being satisfied with such evidence, and that the alien is of good character, shall grant to such alien a certificate in Form B.
