This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of July 26th, 1951.

Enclosed, herewith, is a letter confirming the naturalization of Yesaku Kubodera on the 5th of June, 1912.

For your information, I would advise, that as Ayako Kubodera was born prior to the father's naturalization and did not enter Canada until 1925 she did not automatically acquire the status of a British subject. Insofar as this Department is concerned she is deemed to be an alien.
