Dear Kunio:

Your letter of June 6th addressed to me here was awaiting my arrival yesterday. The one sent to Banff has not been forwarded to me yet. I left this address there, but the regular mail by train is very erratic just now.

I shall be very glad to look into Mr. Maikawa's former business for him while I am here. I shall await receipt of the authorization signed by him before getting in touch with the Custodian's office as I do not think he would give me access to the records without this --- and maybe not then.

I take it that Mr. Maikawa has not put in a claim for the value of his shares since these were not actually disposed of by the Custodian. I am not now familiar with the Custodian's powers under the Canadian Trading with the Enemy Act or Defence of Canada Regulations, or whatever legislation applies to such cases. If you have the facts at hand you might inform me. In any case, however, I will take a look at the property and try to gain access to the Custodian's records and sound him out on his intentions. I will keep you informed of progress.
