Re: T. Maikawa Stores Limited

Your letter of the 20th December, 1948, with reference to the above-named company was received by Mr. Tokio Maikawa, 173 Donlands Ave., Toronto. The letter advised him that after a meeting of the company which was scheduled for the 21st December, a distribution of the proceeds from the sale of the company property would be made, and in due course, he would receive his share of such proceeds.
