
Subject: Proposed revocation certificate of
Canadian citizenship on the grounds
of ordinary residence outside of Canada
for a period of not less than six years,
and failure to maintain substantial
connection with Canada.

You are hereby notified that the question of
the revocation of your Canadian citizenship, on the
grounds cited above, was considered on May 18, 1954 by
a Commission appointed under the provisions of section 19
of the Canadian Citizenship Act and that the hearing was
adjourned until the next meeting awaiting a reply to the
notice of hearing which was sent to you on March 9, 1954.

You are hereby given peremptory notice that the
further hearing and consideration of your case will take
place in Court Room No. 1, City Hall, Toronto, Ontario, on
September 14, 15 and 16, 1954 commencing at 11 a.m. each day.

You may, if you so desire, submit to the Commission
any further representations in writing, against the
proposed revocation of your citizenship, and in addition,
you may name any person or persons to represent you at
the hearing. Your reply should be received not later
than August 25, 1954.

Failing you to show cause on the above dates,
the matter will then be proceeded with by default or as if
the question of revocation had been taken as confessed and
the Commission shall then proceed making report as it may
think fit and just under the circumstances. Please
address your reply to the undersigned at Ottawa.
