
Re: Reizo Shigei,

Reference is made to our letter of February 4,
1954 in connection with the above named person.

We were recently advised by the Department of
Citizenship and Immigration, Ottawa, that the Canadian citizen-
ship of Mr. Reizo Shigei was revoked and cancelled on the 3rd
day of November, 1954.

Article 14 of the Peace Treaty with Japan gives
Canada the right to seize, sell and dispose of assets belonging
to this person. Pursuant to the Appropriation Act of 1952 such
liquidated assets were transferred to the Minister of Finance
for payment of War Claims.
