1. That I am a Canadian citizen by naturalization on October 8, 1948.

2. That my actual place of residence and particulars of my residence on and since the second day of September, 1939, are as follows:

(a) On September 2, 1939 - Fearndonville Road, R.R. No. 1, Abbotsford, B.C.

(b) On or about February 25, 1942, moved to Road Camp, Aldreda, B.C., on Canadian National Railway Line.

(c) On or about March 25, 1942, returned to home at Fearndonville Road, Abbotsford, B.C.

(d) On or about April 17, 1942, moved to 15 Mile Camp, Hope-Princeston Highway, Hope, B.C.

(e) On or about October 15, 1942, moved to Greenwood, B.C.

(f) On or about June 15, 1946, moved to Vineland, Ontario.

(g) On or about December 25, 1946, moved to 305 King Street West, Toronto, Ontario.

(h) On or about February 15, 1951, moved to 76 Normandy Boulevard, Toronto, Ontario.

3. That I have not been interned.

4. That I was part-owner of real property located at 3683 Fearndonville Road, Abbotsford, and that I have an interest in the assets derived from the sale of this property.

5. That I became part-owner of property by purchase from my brother, Kyuemon or Kyuemon Yonemitsu, in 1927, and in addition, by virtue of Power of Attorney asserted by my brother, Kyuemon or Kyuemon Yonemitsu, on

March 13, 1952.

6. That no person, corporation or society, residing or established in a country which has been at war with Canada, has any interest in the said assets.
