

Re: Joji YASHIKI, Reg. #06016

YASHIKI, Wakamatsu, Father, Naturalized, Reg. #02639

On March, 1942, my son, Joji Yashiki, Reg. #06016, was informed by the General Notice put out at Steveston, B.C. to appear before the R.C.M.P. in Vancouver. At this interview he was told to go to a road camp.

Hearing rumours that person who had agreed to sign to go to road camp were immediately collected at the R.C.M.P barrack basement until their departure, he decided to evacuate with the family and friends, therefore, returned home. He also heard at that time that the conditions at the road camps were bad.

A few days later the R.C.M.P. appeared and without any comment put my son into custody to be interned against my wishes.
