You will recall our recent correspondence to you of August 8th when the subject of the coming National JCCA Financial Campaign for the 1949 - '50 Budget was brought to your Chapter's attention. In this correspondence, which was also directed to the other Provincial Chapters, it was requested by this office that if it is your desire to submit suggestions with regard to the JCCA Finance Drive, these suggestions should be submitted to us.

We wish to inform you that the planning of the JCCA financial campaign is well under way. The National Executive Committee has officially set the date of October 1st as the beginning of the JCCA Finance Campaign. This official date, which is in advance of the dates set last year, was set in order to give consideration to the wishes of some of the Provincial Chapters who desire to conduct a finance campaign in October or early November.

Announcement of this date is being made in the NEW CANADIAN in this October 1st issue. In the announcement, the general public is being informed of the fact that the Third National Conference is being held in the third month of the new fiscal year which necessitates the National JCCA to set a tentative budget figure for this financial campaign. The tentative figure of \$8,000.00 has been announced with explanations made that consideration was given to the budget figures of \$7,560.00 for the fiscal year 1947 - '48, and \$8,750.00 for the fiscal year 1948 - '49 in the setting of this objective.

The National Executive Committee, after studying the matter of the 1949 - '50 national budget, proposes the following breakdowns:
