Certified to be a true copy of a Minute of a Meeting of
the Committee of the Privy Council, approved by His
Excellency the Governor General on the 15 July 1952.

The Committee of the Privy Council, on the
recommendation of the Acting Minister of Finance,
concurrent in by the Prime Minister for the Secretary
of State, advise that, under the authority of Vote
696, The Appropriation Act, No. 4, 1952, it is pre-
scribed that the Custodian of Enemy Property transfer
forthwith to the Minister of Finance the following
assets now vested in the Custodian in respect of
World War II:

- (a) Bonds of Canada on the total par value
of \$5 million being securities formerly
owned by German enemies or acquired with
the proceeds or earnings of former German
enemy assets;
- (b) Bonds of Canada of the total par value
of \$2,680,000 being securities formerly
owned by Japanese enemies or acquired
with the proceeds or earnings of former
Japanese enemy assets; and
- (c) Cash in the amount of \$320,000 being
former Japanese enemy assets or the
proceeds or earnings thereof.
