Dear Ray - Rec'd yours of 17th Dec a few minutes ago and I  
am answering you "EK Dam". You are very fortunate. I know you  
very much. As I have told you previously I have not had official  
leave since I joined up - no matter where we went - we were kicked  
off like cattle - there is nothing to see very much in Malaya  
and life continues in its drab ways - when I first arrived at  
Singapore I thought I was in China - the majority of the  
population are Chinese roughly 70% and it gives one the  
atmosphere of being in China - Our situation here is in a  
fluid state - We do not know whether we are staying or leaving -  
Unofficially we are to stay - but the outcome. Nobody knows -  
This is the set up - C.M.H.Q. requested the return of all Canadian  
Personnel in SEAC and practically all the officers has left us.  
but we are kept behind with this unit (Advance Seatic) for  
further work in this area for war crimes - C.M.H.Q. wants  
us back but Seatic also needs us. - the negotiation  
between CMHQ & Seatic is in process and we are waiting  
for the answer - If I am to stay I am demanding my  
rank and number badge - we have been kicked around so
