Regarding the repatriation of the "Gripsholm" last we are informed that the selection of repatriates was made by the Japanese Government. There was an instance here that a man who had been duly advised by telegram of his repatriation, by an unknown reason, became impossible to be repatriated just before the sailing of "Gripsholm." There are several persons here besides him who are wishing to be included in the repatriates on the next "exchange boat."

Is it possible that a list of the names of these persons could be sent through you to the Japanese Government for their approval?

We are only pleased to submit to you any necessary details concerning them.
