Dear Sir;

I wish to advise all Japanese of the following:

"In the ordinary course of events, advice of deaths of Japanese Nationals in Canada is sent to Japan - advice of deaths of Naturalized Canadians and Nisei is not; however, upon the request of a relative of a deceased Canadian subject of Japanese origin, it will be possible to advise relatives in Japan of the death. This request should be made to the Spanish Consul, Protecting Power for Japanese interests in Canada."

Will you please make this information known to all the Japanese in your territory, and continue to advise me of all deaths of Japanese Nationals.
