Gentlemen:

I am writing to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of December 11, 1943, concerning repatriation in the future of Japanese from Canada. If you could furnish me with a list of names of people in your settlement desiring repatriation, I shall be glad to forward the list to my Government for transmission to the Imperial Government. In the preparation of this list, would you be good enough to include the following information: full name, nationality, Japanese Registration Number, date of birth, present address and address prior to evacuation, names and ages of wife and children in Canada, Genseki in Japan and name of any close dependent now living there with relationship, and any special reason for desiring to be repatriated.

Please send a copy of every such list also to Mr. Fernando de Kobbe, Consul of Spain at Vancouver, B. C.
