Dear Sir;

In the latter part of March last, I wrote to you requesting that you prepare a revised list of deaths of Japanese Nationals in your community. To date this has not been received.

Would you please be good enough to prepare this information for me at your earliest opportunity, being careful to show the following details:

1. Name of deceased.
2. Place of civil registry in Japan (Genseki)
3. Date of birth
4. Civil state and occupation.
5. Name of concentration camp.
6. Date of death
7. Place of death.
8. Cause of death (in case of violent death, as much detail as possible)
9. Name of next of kin.
10. Other details which might be useful.

Please make a point of sending me details on all deaths of Japanese Nationals which may occur from this day on, giving all the above information. If there is any change on your committees, please see that in-coming members are informed of this request.
