I am writing to inform you that I have assumed charge of this office on the seventh of November. I have no doubt that you will show me the same co-operation that you gave to my predecessor in the protection of Japanese interests in Canada, and hope that amicable relations may at all times be maintained between you and the Consulate General.

Would you be good enough to inform all Japanese people in your settlement, who are desirous of registering with their Government births, marriages or deaths since the outbreak of war, to send complete information regarding these events individually or through the Committee to this office. In this connection, I should appreciate very much if you would provide me with five copies of any lists or documents of significance.

I wish you and your people the best of health and happiness during the New Year.
