MEMORANDUM

The inquiry from Miss Wakabayashi seems to come under two heads.

First, the cancellation of the agreement to return to Japan. At this time I do not think the Government has reached any conclusion upon the course to be followed. That is, whether people who asked to be returned to Japan will be allowed to change their minds or not. Upon this phase there is nothing I can do. It is simply a matter for the Dominion Government and I think it will be necessary to wait until their decision is known.

Upon the second question I think it would be wiser not to be in too much of a hurry to decide the part of Canada to go to. I think Miss Wakabayashi had better wait until the decision of the Government is known and then let me hear again.
