We have your recent letter and note your desire to reinstate your policy which at present is in a lapsed condition and would advise that in reinstating this policy the Company would require payment of the arrears together with evidence that you are enjoying good health, this would mean a complete medical examination the cost of which would be borne by yourself. For your information, would advise that in April, 1945 the indebtedness amounted to \$238.35, so in addition to this amount there would be 1945 and 1946 premiums of \$69.90 each, plus interest up to the present time, or a total of \$393.55 would be required to place your policy up to date in every respect. You may wish to write us further in the matter, for in view of the heavy arrears you might wish to purchase new insurance which would require a considerable less outlay at present than to reinstate your present policy.
