DRAFT PROPOSAL: VANCOUVER JCCA REDRESS COMMITTEE

FROM: JCCA REDRESS STEERING COMMITTEE

I. TERMS OF REFERENCE:

1. The Vancouver JCCA Redress Committee shall be a subcommittee of the Board of the Vancouver JCCA.

2. It shall represent the Greater Vancouver Japanese Canadian community on matters pertaining to redress at both the local and national levels.

3. It shall disseminate information in the Greater Vancouver Japanese Canadian community on the redress program through a) public meetings, b) regular reports in the Bulletin, c) and other media outlets.

4. It shall advise and make recommendations to the JCCA Board of Directors on policy decisions pertaining to redress matters.

5. It shall assist, wherever feasible, the JCCA Board of Directors in the fund-raising campaign for the JCCA redress program.

6. It shall send the alternate delegate to National Association of Japanese Canadians (NAJC) Council meetings to advise the NAJC Council member from the JCCA Board of Directors on the Greater Vancouver Japanese Canadian position on redress.

II. STRUCTURE:

1. The Vancouver JCCA Redress Committee shall consist of a maximum of 25 members and a minimum of 12, of which:

a) 2 shall be appointed by the JCCA Board of Directors as liaison representatives;

b) a minimum of 5 shall be reserved for representation from the Issei community;

c) 17 shall be elected at large from the community.

2. The Executive shall consist of a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Treasurer, and Secretary.

3. The Executive shall be elected by the JCCA Redress Committee.

4. Subcommittees shall be established as necessary.

III. MODE OF ELECTION:

1. Call for nominations in the Bulletin, to be published August 16.
